

Ladies and Gentlemen,

Ukraine established **visa free regime** for citizens of **Swiss Confederation Liechtenstein, European Union, USA, Canada, Japan, Andorra, Iceland, Monaco, Norway, Republic of Korea, San Marino and Vatican** According to this regulation visas are not required for citizens who enter Ukraine or transit through its territory for a period of up to 90 days with a valid travel passport. For the citizens who enter Ukraine with the purpose of **employment, permanent residency, study** visas are required.

The only one Consular section in Switzerland located in **Bern 3005, Feldeggweg 5**. Our reception hours: **Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 09-00 to 12-30**. To go to the Consular section you can take tram №3 or №5 till the station: **Helvetiaplatz** It is possible to apply for the visa at the Consular section of the Embassy personally or all documents may be submitted to the Consulate by mail. Processing of the visa request takes 10 working days. You can also apply an express visa for 3 working days under personal agreement. **Only completed set of the following documents** is accepted.

We have the following **tariffs** (in Swiss francs)

2. Double entry (6 month)	115	230
3. Multiple for one years	236	472
4. Tourist visa (with confirmation of hotel booking from Ukraine or with ticket of Ukraine International Airlines)	75	150
5. Transit visa (double entry)	65	130
6. Transit visa (multiple)	135	270
7. Group visa	50% of corresponding tariff	50% of corresponding tariff
